Menthol (6.5%w/w), Methyl Salicylate (6.5%w/w), Camphor (3.0%w/w), Thymol (1.0%w/w)

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What PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN is used for

For relief of aches and pains associated with: muscle fatigue, muscle pain, stiff shoulders, backache, bruises, sprains, strains, arthritis.

How PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN works

PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN contains active ingredients Menthol, Methyl Salicylate, Camphor and Thymol. Menthol, when applied to skin, dilates the blood vessels causing a sensation of coldness followed by an analgesic effect. Applied externally. Methyl Salicylate is used to relieve pain in musculoskeletal, joint, and soft-tissue disorders. Camphor acts as a rubefacient and mild analgesic. Thymol is an disinfectant which also has antifungal properties.

Before you use PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN

When you must not use it

Do not use PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN if

1. You are taking warfarin, excessive application onto the skin for muscles or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding
2. You have skin sensitization or contact dermatitis.
3. The application area is directly into the nostrils

Before you start to use it

Check with your doctor or pharmacist If you are allergic to Methyl Salicylate, Menthol, Camphor, Thymol, or to any other ingredients in this product.

Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are currently taking warfarin.

How to use PLASTER BERUBAT NEOBUN

How much to use

Not more than 3 to 4 times daily. Remove after at most 8 hours.

When to use it

Use to provides for relief of aches and pains associated with: muscle fatigue, muscle pain, stiff shoulder, backache, bruises, sprains, strains, arthritis.

How long to use it

Usage should continue when there are signs of muscle fatigue, muscle pain, stiff shoulder, backache, bruises, sprains, strains, arthritis.

Consult a doctor or pharmacist if the pain does not improve after 5 to 6 days of use.

If you forgot to use it

Use the product as soon as possible and continue to use as normal usage.

If you use too much(overdose)

For user taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for muscle and joint pains may increase chances of bleeding.

If you use too much of this product, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

While you are using it

Things you must do

Keep the applied area from getting wet.

Things you must not do

This product should not be used on infants below 2 years of age and is contraindicated in those with sensitivity to any of the ingredients of the product

Things to be careful of

For external use only
Keep out of reach of children

Side effects

Do not use if you are allergic to aspirin or salicylate. Stop using and consult doctor if condition worsen, rash, itching, or excessive skin irritation occur.

The ingredients are Menthol Methyl Salicylate, Camphor, Thymol, Rubber Adhesive Solution 20% solid content, Polyisobutene, Zinc Oxide, Aliphatic Hydrocarbon Resin, Lanolin Anhydrous and Peppermint Oil.
