What EUROSAN is used for

EUROSAN is for relief muscle and joint pain.

How EUROSAN works

EUROSAN contains active ingredients Menthol, Methyl Salicylate and Camphor. Menthol, when applied to skin, dilates the blood vessels causing a sensation of coldness followed by an analgesic effect. Applied externally. Methyl Salicylate is used to relieve pain in musculoskeletal, joint, and soft-tissue disorders. Camphor acts as a rubefacient and mild analgesic.

Before you use EUROSAN

When you must not use it

Do not use EUROSAN if

1. You are taking warfarin, excessive application onto the skin for muscles or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding
2. You have skin sensitization or contact dermatitis.
3. The application area is directly into the nostrils

Before you start to use it

Check with your doctor or pharmacist

If you are allergic to Methyl Salicylate,

Menthol, Camphor or to any other ingredients in this product.

Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are currently taking warfarin.

How to use EUROSAN

How much to use

Apply one to two times a day.

When to use it

Use to provides for relief muscle and joint pain.

How long to use it

Usage should continue when there are signs of muscle and joint pain.

Consult a doctor or pharmacist if the pain does not improve after 5 to 6 days of use.

If you forgot to use it

Use the product as soon as possible and continue to use as normal usage.

If you use too much(overdose)

For user taking warfarin, excessive application on the skin for muscle and joint pains may increase chances of bleeding.

If you use too much of this product, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

While you are using it

Things you must do

Keep the applied area from getting wet.

Things you must not do

This product should not be used on infants below 2 years of age and is contraindicated in those with sensitivity to any of the ingredients of the product

Things to be careful of

For external use only

Keep out of reach of children

Side effects

Discontinue of rash, itching, redness or eruption occurs.

What it looks like

EUROSAN is a white fabric rectangular plaster coated with a thin layer of medicated colloid.

Ingredients

The ingredients are Menthol, Methyl Salicylate, Camphor, Thymol, Borneol, Rubber Adhesive Solution, Polyisobutene, Zinc Oxide, Aliphatic Hydrocarbon Resin, Lanolin Anhydrous, Peppermint Oil, Clove Oil, and Oleoresin Capsicum.
