What Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment is used for

It is used for symptomatic relief of blocked nose, cough, muscular aches, and pains due to colds.

How Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment works

It contains camphor, eucalyptus oil and menthol.

Menthol and camphor have mild analgesic and rubefacient properties.

Eucalyptus oil has also been applied as a rubefacient.

Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment gives a sensation of warmth and relief when it is rubbed on the chest and back. It gives clear and easy breathing.

Before you use Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment

- When you must not use it

Do not use it if you are allergic to any ingredients of Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment. Do not use it on children below 2 years of age.

- Before you start to use it

Initially apply a small amount to a limited skin area and observe whether there is discomfort or itch before applying to a larger skin area. Discontinue use if irritation develops.

Please follow the advice of your doctor or pharmacist.

- Pregnancy and lactation

Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using this product. This product should not be used on the mother's chest during breastfeeding.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment

- How much to use

Apply Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment on the throat, chest and back when necessary. For deeper relief, add a small amount of Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment to a bowl of hot (not boiling) water and inhale the vapour for 10 – 15 minutes. When using this product, do not apply heat, microwave or add to boiling water.

For external use only. Not to be taken orally.

- When to use it

Use it when necessary.

- How long to use it

Use it when necessary.

- If you forget to use it

Use it as soon as you remember.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital if you think you or anyone else may have used too much of this medicine.

While you are using Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment

- Things you must do

Use your medicine exactly as your doctor or pharmacist has told you.

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medicine.

- Things you must not do

- Do not apply to open wounds or damaged skin.
- Do not heat, microwave or add to boiling water when using Durio MediRub Medicated Vaporising Ointment as it can cause burns.
- Do not apply over large areas of the body or bandage or use with heating pads

- Things to be careful of

This product is contraindicated in children below 2 years of age. Caution must be exercised when older children are treated. It is dangerous to place any camphor containing product into the nostril of children. A small amount applied this way may cause immediate collapse.

Avoid contact with the eyes and mucous membrane.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Durio Medirub Medicated Vaporising Ointment can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Side effects may include occasional hypersensitivity and skin irritation.

Storage and Disposal of Durio Medirub Medicated Vaporising Ointment

- Storage

Store below 30°C. Protect from direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
