

Boric acid (1.0% w/v) and Borax (0.25% w/v)

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What Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops is used for

It is used to relieve minor eye irritations such as itchiness and burning sensation in the eyes caused by exposure to harsh outdoor environment such as glare, dust, smoke and other airborne pollutants.

How Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops works

Boric Acid has a weak bacteriostatic and fungistatic properties. It has generally been superseded by more effective and less toxic disinfectants. Boric Acid is used, with Sodium Borate (Borax), as buffer and antimicrobial in eye drop.

Before you use Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops

- When you must not use it

Do not use Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops if you are allergic to any ingredient in this medicine.

- Before you start use it

Tell your doctor or pharmacist before using Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops if you:

- are pregnant or plan to pregnant.
- are breast-feeding or plan to start breast-feeding.
- are using other eye medicament
- wearing contact lenses

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or having recently taken any other medicines. This includes any medicines

which you have bought without a prescription.

How to use Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops

- How much to use

For topical eye use only. Instill 2-3 drops in the affected eye(s), 3-4 times a day or as needed.

- When to use it

Follow the prescription from your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Continue using Eye Glo Regular Eye Drop for as long as doctor recommend. Ask your doctor or pharmacist before prolonged use of this medicine.

- If you forget to use it

Use it as soon as you remember. Then, next use it at the usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Flush your eyes with tap water or seek immediate medical attention if you have used too much or are worried with your condition.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

- Always wash your hand before handle the medicine.
- Remove contact lenses before using
- Replace cap immediately after each use
- Use medicine at the same time each day

- Things you must not do

- Do not swallow the solution.
- Do not insert contact lenses immediately after using this product. Insert back at least 15 minutes later.
- Do not use if solution changes colour or becomes cloudy
- Do not allow tip of container to touch any other surface to avoid contamination.
- Not recommended for use with soft lenses.

- Do not use this solution 4 weeks after first opening.

- Things to be careful of

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you:

- are allergic to any other ingredients in this medicine.
- are pregnant or breast-feeding.
- experience changes in vision.
- Feel discomfort after using or condition worsen after use
- Encounter infections or inflammation

Side effects

May cause transient mild stinging or temporary blurred vision. If you experience severe eye pain, changes in vision, continued redness of irritation of the eye, or if symptoms worsen or persist, discontinue use and consult your medical practitioner.

Seek immediate medical attention if you experience any side effects or allergic reactions.

Storage and Disposal of Eye Glo Regular Eye Drops

- Storage

Store in a dry place below 30°C. Discard 4 weeks after opening. Keep out of the reach of the children. Do not use this medicine after expiry date.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
