Methyl salicylate (25.00% w/w), Menthol (14.50% w/w), Camphor (7.68% w/w)

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What is CNI Fire Sens Forte Mentholated Rub used for

Provides symptomatic relief of muscle and joint pain, rheumatism, backache and sprains

How does CNI Fire Sens Forte Mentholated Rub work

Applied externally, it will cause a cool sensation, followed by a warm soothing and analgesic effect which may last several hours

Before you use CNI Fire Sens Forte Mentholated Rub

- When you must not use it

Persons with known or suspected allergies or intolerance to any ingredients in the product

- Before you start to use it

Test on a small area of your skin if you suspect to have sensitive skin or be allergic to any ingredients in the product

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines that you buy with or without prescription

For patients taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for muscle or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding

How to use CNI Fire Sens Forte Mentholated Rub

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help

- How much to use

Use only sufficient amount onto the affected area

- When to use it

Use when needed or directed by your doctor or pharmacist

- How long to use it

Recommended to use up to 3 to 4 times a day or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist

- If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor on what you should do if you forgot to use it. You may continue to experience symptomatic discomforts listed

- If you use too much (overdose)

You may experience symptoms of discomfort such as dizziness, nausea or vomiting. Discontinue use immediately and consult a doctor or go to the nearest hospital emergency department

While you are using CNI Fire Sens Forte Mentholated Rub

- Things you must do

Apply on affected area gently until completely absorbed. For pregnant women and nursing women please consult a doctor before use

- Things you must not do

- Avoid contact with eyes
- Do not apply to wounds or damaged skin

- Avoid direct application into nostrils
- Camphor can cause convulsion. Do not use on infants below 2 years of age
- Keep away from mucous membranes, open wounds
- Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist

- Things to be careful of

- If symptoms persist, please consult a doctor or pharmacist
- This product is contraindicated in children below 2 years of age
- It is dangerous to place any camphor containing product into the nostril of children. A small amount applied this way may cause immediate collapse
- Caution must be exercised when older children are treated

Side effects

May cause hypersensitivity/allergic reactions, including contact dermatitis in some individuals with sensitive skin

- Storage

Store below 30°C, in a dry place. Keep out of reach of children

- Disposal
