Tolnaftate (1%w/v)

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What Wintinea Lotion is used for

Wintinea Lotion indicated for the treatment of fungal skin infections including athlete's foot, jock itch, body ringworm, and nail infections.

How Wintinea Lotion works

Wintinea Lotion contains Tolnaftate which inhibits the growth of fungus.

Before you use Wintinea Lotion

- When you must not use it

Do not use if you are hypersensitivity to tolnaftate or any other ingredients in this product.

- Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and lactation

Consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine.

- Taking other medicines

Care should be taken when using together with other topical medicines.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are using any other medicines.

How to use Wintinea Lotion

- How much to use

Clean and dry the infected area. Apply the lotion thinly and evenly onto the infected area. Wash hands before and after using this lotion.

- When to use it

Use twice daily as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Use for the duration that your doctor or pharmacist recommends.

To prevent recurrence, continue treatment for another 2 weeks after symptoms disappear.

A total of 4 to 6 weeks treatment period may be necessary. Longer treatment period may be required for nail infection.

Treatment may be repeated if infection recurs.

- If you forget to use it

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have used too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Use your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Discontinue use and consult physician if

- Itching, burning or infection do not improve within 10 days
- become worse or irritation occurs

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using the medicine unless advised by your doctor.

Not recommended for use in infants and children under 2 years of age.

- Things to be careful of

For external use only. Avoid contact with eyes, nose and mouth. Not to be taken.

Side Effects

Wintinea Lotion is generally well tolerated when applied on the skin. Rarely skin irritation, redness or dryness may occur.

Storage and Disposal of Wintinea Lotion

- Storage

- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- Store below 30°C.
- Protect from light.
- Keep cap tightly closed.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
