

WINDERM CREAM
(Antifungal - Antibacterial)

Active Ingredient:

Econazole Nitrate 1%w/w
Preservative - Chlorocresol 0.1%w/w

Presentations:

Tube of 10g and box of 10g x 50 tubes.

Product Descriptions:

White smooth cream.

Pharmacology:

Econazole Nitrate is an imidazole antifungal agent which acts against dermatophytes (*Trichophyton*, *Epidermophyton*, *Microsporum*, *Pityrosporum*); pathogenic yeast (*Candida albicans* and other candida species) and moulds. The mechanism of action is by damaging the cell membrane, thus increasing the permeability to substance otherwise cannot penetrate into the intact cells, and therefore killing them. It is also active against Gram positive bacteria, eg. *Staphylococci*, *Streptococci*, *Bacillus anthracis* and *Bacteroides fragilis*.
The absorption is not significant when Econazole Nitrate is applied to the skin.

Indications:

For treatment of dermatophytic infections in adults and children including tinea corporis, tinea cruris, tinea pedis, tinea versicolor and cutaneous candidiasis.

Directions of Use:

Clean the affected area with warm water. Apply 2 times a day (morning and evening) and rub in gently with the finger. Application to be continued for full time of treatment (2 to 4 weeks) so as to prevent relapse.

Symptoms and Treatments of Overdose:

Not applicable since the absorption through skin is not significant.

Contraindications:

Patients who have previously exhibited hypersensitivity to imidazole. Extensive and prolonged usage in infants and during pregnancy should be avoided.

Precautions:

For external use only. Avoid in contact with eyes, nose and mouth. Not to be taken.

Discontinue treatment if irritation or hypersensitivity occurs. Intractable candidiasis or lack of response following prolonged use may indicate diabetic condition or to rule out other pathogens. If symptoms persist, please consult a doctor.

Use in Pregnancy and Lactation:

Safety in pregnancy has not been established. Econazole should not be used in pregnant woman or in those likely to become pregnant unless the expected benefit outweighs the potential risk.

It is not known whether Econazole is excreted in breast milk or whether it has harmful effect on the new born. However as systemic absorption is low in humans, any excretion into breast milk is likely to be low.

Interaction with other medicaments:

Do not use any other skin products on the affected area without consulting your doctor or health professional.

Undesirable Effects:

Winderm Cream is well tolerated by most skin types. If local irritations occur on eczematous skin areas, apply an anti-eczematous therapy a few days prior to treatment with Winderm Cream. Absorption through skin is minimal to contribute any systemic effect.

Storage:

Store below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep cap tightly closed after opening. Keep out of reach of children. Jauhkan daripada capaian kanak-kanak.

3 years from the date of manufacture.
