## What HOE Zinc Cream is used for

HOE Zinc Cream is a mild astringent to the skin. It soothes and protects eczema and slight skin picking disorder.

## How HOE Zinc Cream works

HOE Zinc Cream contains active ingredient Zinc Oxide, which acts as a mild astringent that provides a physical barrier to prevent skin irritation and help heal damaged skin.

## Before you use HOE Zinc Cream

### -When you must not use it

Do not apply HOE Zinc Cream if:

- You are allergic to Zinc Oxide or to any components in this preparation.

### -Before you start to take it

Tell your doctor if you have or have had any of the following medical conditions:

- You have allergies to medicines, foods, or other substances

### Pregnancy and breast feeding:

It is not known whether Zinc Oxide will harm an unborn baby. Talk to your doctor before using this medicine if you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breast-feeding.

### -Taking other medicines

Tell your pharmacist or doctor if you are taking any other products (such as over the counter medicines, prescribed medicines and herbal products). There is no known of medicine interactions with HOE Zinc Cream have been reported.

## How to use HOE Zinc Cream

### -How much to use

Apply 2-3 times daily.

Always use HOE Zinc Cream as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

### -When to use it

Wash and dry the affected area thoroughly before applying the cream.

### -How long to use it

Consult your doctor for the exact duration of this medicine.

### -If you forget to use it

If you forget to use your cream at the right time, use it as soon as you remember, then carry on as before. Do not double the dose to catch up.

### -If you take too much (overdose)

If, by mistake on a few occasions you use more than you should, do not worry. If you apply a lot or a lot is accidentally swallowed, it could make you ill. Talk to your doctor or go to the hospital as soon as possible.

## While you are using HOE Zinc Cream

### -Things you must do

If you are about to start taking on any other new medicine, medicines obtained without prescription and herbal medicines, tell your doctor or pharmacist that you are using HOE Zinc Cream.

### -Things you must not do

Discontinue use if irritation or sensitivity develops. If you are not sure, talk to your doctor or pharmacist before using.

### -Things to be careful of

Avoid getting this medication in your mouth or eyes. If does happen, rinse with water right away.

Get medical attention for more severe skin irritation or injury.

If your condition does not improve, stop using this medication and call your doctor.

**Side effects**

HOE Zinc Cream can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. As with all medicines, some people may be allergic to the cream.

If any side effect becomes severe, or you notice any side effect not listed here, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website [npra.gov.my](http://npra.gov.my) (Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)).

**Storage and Disposal of HOE Zinc Cream**

-Storage

Store below 30°C.  
Keep container well closed.  
Protect from light.  
Keep out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Dispose the medicine after the expiry date.  
Consult your pharmacist on how to safely dispose of any medicines no longer required.
