Content

Papain B.P.C. 20,000 USP Units per capsule

Indications

For edema and inflammatory conditions.

Pharmacology

Papain, a proteolytic enzyme, exhibits broad spectrum specificity; peptides, amides, esters, and thioesters all being susceptible to papain-catalysed hydrolysis.

Adverse Effects

Urticaria, pruritus, dizziness, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea and sensitisation may occur occasionally.

Precautions

Safety for use in pregnancy and lactation has not been established.

Contraindications

- Not recommended in patients with blood coagulation disorders or with generalised or systemic infections.
- Avoid co-administration with anticoagulants.

Dosage and administration

Adults : Oral, 2 capsules 4 times daily for 5 days.

Children : As directed by physician.

Storage : Keep container tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry place below 30°C away from light.
