other medicines, especially warfarin (used to prevent blood clots), or any that you buy from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

- This product contains methyl salicylate and when applied or rub on to the skin, can be absorbed through the skin into the blood. For patients taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for muscle or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding.

- Do not give Chimpanzee to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

### - Things to be careful of

- For external use only. Do not apply on open wounds, near the eyes, mouth, or directly into the nostrils.
- Caution must be exercised when older children (above 2 years) are treated. It is dangerous to place any camphor containing product into the nostrils of children. A small amount applied in this way may cause immediate collapse.

## What Chimpanzee is used for

It is used to relieve mild to moderate pain associated with rheumatic problems, bruises, sprain, muscle cramps, muscle or joints pain and lower back pain.

## How Chimpanzee works

Chimpanzee Brand Medicated Oil contains the active ingredients Camphor Synthetic, Eucalyptus Oil, Menthol, Peppermint Oil, Turpentine Oil and Methyl Salicylate. When massaged gently on the skin, it will produce a cooling sensation followed by sensation of warmth to relieve the pain.

## Before you use Chimpanzee

- When you must not use it
  - If you are allergic to camphor, eucalyptus oil, menthol, peppermint oil, turpentine oil, methyl salicylate, or any other ingredients of this product (listed in Product Description).
  - Do not use on children below 2 years old.

### - Before you start to use it

Use with caution when treating children aged 2 years and above.

- Pregnancy and lactation
  - Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine.

- Taking other medicines
  - This medicine is for external application and will usually have minimal effect on other medication. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any

## How to use Chimpanzee

- How much to use
  - Apply or rub a small amount as directed by your doctor or pharmacist on affected parts of body.
- When to use it
  - Can apply 3 to 4 times a day, or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it
  - Use for the duration that your doctor or pharmacist recommends.

- If you forget to use it
  - Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for the next dose, skip the missed dose and then continue to apply the medicine according to the schedule as usual. Do not apply a double dose to replace the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)
  - Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have used too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

## While you are using Chimpanzee

- Things you must do
  - Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Chimpanzee.
  - Keep out of reach of children.

- Things you must not do
  - Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

## Driving and using machines

- Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how Chimpanzee affects you. If this product makes you feel dizzy or sick, do not drive or use machines and contact your doctor immediately.

## Side effects

Like all medicines, Chimpanzee can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Possible side effects include:

- headache
- dizziness
- nausea
- vomiting
- skin irritation

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine.

## Storage and Disposal of Chimpanzee

- Storage
  - Store below 30° C in a dry place.

Do not use this product after the expiry date.

## Disposal
