What Zhui Feng Yew is used for

It used for symptomatic relief for muscle and joint pain, swelling and bruises.

How Zhui Feng Yew works

Methyl salicylate, menthol and camphor are external analgesics which stimulate sensation of warmth and/ or cold. This produces a counter irritant response which provides temporary relief of minor aches and pains of muscles and joints associated with backache, arthritis, strains and sprains.

Before you use Zhui Feng Yew

- When you must not use it

Do not use it if you are allergic to any ingredients of this Zhui Feng Yew.

- Before you start to use it

Initially apply a small amount to a limited skin area and observe whether there is discomfort or itch before applying to a larger skin area. Discontinue use if irritation develops.

- Taking other medicines

Please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

For patients taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for muscle or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding.

How to use Zhui Feng Yew

- How much to use

Rub on affected area 3 to 4 times a day.

For external use only. Not to be taken.

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully.

They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

Continue to use it as directed by your doctor or on the package label.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine.

Symptoms include headache, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, skin irritation, contact dermatitis, rash, itching, redness or swelling, burning or stinging sensation, may controlled by reducing the dosage.

While you are using Zhui Feng Yew

- Things you must do

- Inform your doctor or pharmacist of all the medications you are taking.
- Avoid contact with eye.

- Things you must not do

- Do not apply to wounds or damaged skin.
- Do not apply to irritated skin
- Do not bandage
- Do not use with heating pad or device
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.

- Things to be careful of

Ask your health care provider any question you may have about how to use Zhui Feng Yew.

Side effects

Headache, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, skin irritation, contact dermatitis, rash, itching, redness or swelling, burning or stinging sensation may occur.

May cause hypersensitivity/ allergic reactions in some individuals with sensitive skin.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring or visiting the website npra.moh.gov.my [Public → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and Disposal of Zhui Feng Yew

- Storage

Store below 30°C. Away from direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
