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WHAT DERMAID CREAM 0.5%w/w IS USED FOR

- For the relief of non-infected dermatitis or eczema, itching rashes of irritant or allergic contact dermatitis and itching vulval and anal areas.

HOW DERMAID CREAM 0.5%w/w WORKS

- Contains dissolved hydrocortisone 0.5%w/w.
- Hydrocortisone is an anti-inflammatory agent. Topical application of corticosteroids often produces dramatic suppression of skin diseases in which inflammation is a prominent feature.

BEFORE YOU USE DERMAID CREAM 0.5%w/w

When you must not use it

Known sensitivity to any of the ingredients; viral skin infections including vaccinia, chicken pox and herpes; fungal

skin infections such as thrush, tinea and ringworm; bacterial skin infections such as impetigo and boils; tuberculosis of the skin and syphilitic skin disorders.

This product should not be used on infected skin, acne or viral diseases of the skin such as cold sores and chicken pox, under covered dressings or on children under 2 years except under medical supervision.

Before you start to use it

Please discuss with your doctor or pharmacist before using the product.

Taking other medicines

Currently there have been no reports of problems when this product is used with other medicines.

HOW TO USE DERMAID CREAM 0.5%w/w

Apply a small amount to affected skin 1 to 3 times daily.

WHILE YOU ARE USING IT

Things to be careful of

Avoid contact with eyes. Do not use on infected skin, acne or viral skin diseases. For external use only. If irritation occurs, wash affected area and discontinue use. If symptoms persist, consult your healthcare practitioner.

SIDE EFFECTS

After application, a slight stinging sensation may occasionally be noticed. This transient symptom is most likely to disappear after several applications. Other side effects may include itching, redness, allergy and thinning of the skin.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF DERMAID CREAM 0.5%w/w

Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep out of reach of children.

Disposal

DermAid Cream 0.5%w/w should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of DermAid Cream 0.5%w/w that is no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
