What Sebitar Scalp Cleansing Treatment is used for

- Relieves itching scalp and reduces inflammation.
- For relief of the symptoms of seborrhoeic dermatitis, (scaling and flaking scalp), eczema and psoriasis of the scalp.

How Sebitar Scalp Cleansing Treatment works

- Pine tar and coal tar have antiitching, anti-inflammatory, thickening of keratin layers and anti-infective actions.
- Salicylic acid has scales removing properties and is applied topically in the treatment of scaling skin conditions such as dandruff and seborrhoeic dermatitis, ichthyosis, psoriasis and acne.

Before you use Sebitar Scalp Cleansing Treatment

- When you must not use it
- With known sensitivity to any ingredients of this product.
- With active or inflamed

- psoriasis, weeping eczema, pus filled blister psoriasis, hair follicle inflammation, acne or light sensitivity.
- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding
- <u>Before you start to use it</u> Please discuss with your doctor or pharmacist before using the product.
- Taking other medicines
 Currently there have been no reports of problems when this product is used with other medicines.

How to use Sebitar Scalp Cleansing Treatment

- How much to use
Wet hair. Apply to affected area.
Massage well. Apply more to remainder of scalp and hair. Work into a lather. Leave for 5 minutes, rinse thoroughly.

- When to use it
Use twice weekly up to once daily if required.

- How long to use it Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it
If forget to use this medicine, use
it as soon as remember. Then
next, use this medicine at the
usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)
Contact your doctor immediately
or go to the Emergency
Department of your nearest
hospital, if you think you or
anyone else may have taken too
much of this medicine. Do this
even if there are no signs of
discomfort or poisoning. You
may need urgent medical
attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

For external use only. Avoid contact with eyes. If Sebitar enters eyes, rinse with clean water. Use Sebitar on the scalp only.

- *Things you must not do*Do not apply to acutely inflamed skin.

<u>Things to be careful of</u>
If there is no improvement, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Side effects

Allergy to any of the ingredients may cause skin irritation. If irritation occurs, discontinue use. Although uncommon, coal tar may have a light sensitivity action.

Sensitisation to tar (pine) may also occur but it is not common.

- Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal
