

POLYLAB CALAMINE LOTION

Calamine (15% w/v)

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What Calamine Lotion is used for

For relief of discomfort due to mild itchiness, insect bites, rashes and sunburn.

How Calamine Lotion works

Contains calamine, which is a mild astringent lotion to help relieve skin rashes and irritation.

Before using Calamine Lotion

When you must not use it

You are allergic to any ingredients present in Calamine Lotion.

Before you start to use it

Please consult your doctor or pharmacist before using it.

Taking other medicines

Please inform your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medications.

How to use Calamine Lotion

How much to use

Shake well before use. Apply lotion to the affected area two to three times daily.

When to use

Follow the directions on the label carefully or as instructed by your doctor or pharmacist.

How long to use

Please refer to your doctor or pharmacist.

If you forget to use it

Apply as soon as you remember. If it is too near the next dose timing, apply the next dose at the normal time. Do not apply extra to make up for the missed dose.

If you use too much (overdose)

Seek medical attention as soon as possible.

While you are using Calamine Lotion

Things you must do

Shake well before use. Consult your doctor or pharmacist if condition persist. Doctor or pharmacist will assess your situation and advise on the need to continue application of Calamine Lotion.

Things you must not do

- Should not be applied to raw surfaces or mucous membrane.
- Do not administer Calamine Lotion to treat other complaints unless advised by your doctor.

Things to be careful of

- For external use only.
- If a burning sensation or rash develops, treatment should be discontinued.

Side Effects

Local sensitivity reactions (extremely rare).

Storage and Disposal of Calamine Lotion

Storage

- Store in a dry place below 30°C.
- Protect from light.

Disposal

Calamine Lotion should not be disposed via wastewater or household waste. Ask advice from pharmacist on the correct disposal of the product once no longer required. This will help to protect the environment.
