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What Wormnil Suspension is used for

Wormnil Suspension is used for the eradication of round worm, pin worm and hook worm, as a single or mixed infestation.

How Wormnil Suspension works

Wormnil Suspension contains pyrantel pamoate, which belongs to a group of medicines called anthelmintics that eliminates parasitic worms infections. It kills the worms.

Before you use Wormnil Suspension

- When you must not use it

Do not take Wormnil Suspension if:

- you are allergic to pyrantel pamoate or to other ingredients in the product.
- you have muscle weakness
- you have impaired liver function.

- Before you start to use it

Please inform doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant or whilst breastfeeding. Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking Wormnil Suspension.

- Taking other medicines

Piperazine (treatment of threadworms and roundworms) may block the effects of pyrantel. Concurrent use is not recommended. Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Wormnil Suspension

- How much to use

6 months – 2 years: 2.5 ml – 5 ml

2 – 6 years: 5 ml

6 – 12 years: 10 ml

Above 12 years: 15 ml

- When to use it

To be taken as a single dose or as directed by the physician.

- How long to use it

Use the medication for the duration as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Not applicable.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If you accidentally take too much Wormnil Suspension (more than your usual daily dose), contact your doctor or nearest hospital for advice. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention if you experience:

- blurred vision; confusion; dizziness, faintness, or lightheadedness when getting up from a lying or sitting position; sweating; unusual tiredness or weakness; irregular heartbeat
- muscle spasm, twitches, and weakness
- difficulty in breathing; loss of consciousness

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Wormnil Suspension.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

- Things you must not do

Do not give Wormnil Suspension to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your pharmacist or doctor tells you to.

- Things to be careful of

Special care is recommended during pregnancy and breastfeeding. Discuss with your doctor about the treatment benefits against possible effects on the child.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Wormnil Suspension can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after taking this medicine. Side effects occur only occasionally and are mild. Reported side effects such as:-

- hypersensitivity (skin rash)
- dizziness; drowsiness; headache; irritability; trouble in sleeping
- gastrointestinal disturbances (abdominal or stomach cramps or pain; diarrhea; loss of appetite; nausea or vomiting)

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers→ Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)]

Storage and disposal of Wormnil Suspension

- Storage

Keep all medicines out of the reach of children.

Store below 30°C in a dry place protected from direct light.

- Disposal

Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer use. These measures will help to protect the environment.
