What Antipain Liniment is used for

Antipain Liniment is used for the relief of muscular and joint pains.

How Antipain Liniment works

Antipain Liniment contains methyl salicylate.

Methyl salicylate is used topically as a counter – irritant. It works by causing the skin to feel cool and then warm that reduces the pain.

Before you use Antipain Liniment

- When you must not use it

Do not use Antipain Ointment if:

- you are allergic to methyl salicylate or any other ingredients of this medicine (listed in Product Description)

- Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and lactation

Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

This product contains methyl salicylate and when applied or rubbed on to the skin, it can be absorbed through the skin into the blood. If you are taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for

muscle or joints pains may increase the chances of bleeding.

How to use Antipain Liniment

- How much to use

This product is for external use only and should not be taken by mouth.

Apply a little to the affected part and gently massage.

- When to use it

Use three to four times a day or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Apply Antipain Liniment for the duration as your doctor recommends. This medicine is usually used for short period of time.

- If you forget to use it

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have used too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention. If the infants accidentally consumed this medicine, it can cause death.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

- Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medication
- Use your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.
- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Antipain Liniment.

- Things you must not do

- Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor.

- Do not give Antipain Liniment to anyone else; even they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

Avoid product contact with the eyes, mucous membrane, inflamed or broken skin.

Driving and using machines

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how Antipain Liniment affects you.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Antipain Liniment can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

This medicine may cause hives and swelling of face and mouth.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)]

Storage and Disposal of Antipain Liniment

- Storage

Keep all medicines out of the reach of children.

Store below 30°C in a dry place protected from direct light.

- Disposal

Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer use. These measures will help to protect the environment.
