

AQUA CREAM

Emulsifying Wax / White Soft Paraffin / Liquid Paraffin (8% w/w / 12% w/w / 8% w/w)

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What Aqua Cream is used for

Aqua Cream is an emollient, to soften or soothe the skin in irritant conditions of the skin

How Aqua Cream works

Moisturizing and protective cream for the treatment of dry skin.

Before you use Aqua Cream

- When you must not use it

Do not use Aqua Cream if you are allergic to any of the ingredients of this medicine. An allergic reaction may include a rash or itching.

- Before you start to use it

If you are pregnant or breast-feeding, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this medicine.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking, have recently taken or might take any other medicines.

The activity of hydroxybenzoates (parabens preservatives) can be adversely affected by the presence of other excipients or active ingredients. There may be adsorption onto substances like magnesium trisilicate, aluminium magnesium silicate, talc, polysorbate 80 or plastics.

Activity can be affected by nonionic surfactants, essential oils, atropine, iron, sorbitol, weak alkalis and strong acids.

How to use Aqua Cream

- When to use it

Always use this medicine exactly as described in this leaflet or as your doctor or pharmacist has told you. Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

- How much to use

Firstly, gently wash and dry the affected areas of your skin.

Apply a thin film of the cream evenly on to affected area 2 to 3 times daily, or as advised by your doctor or pharmacist.

Wipe away any excess cream with a tissue.

- How long to use it

How long you will have to use this cream will depend on how quickly your condition improves.

- If you forget to use it

Do not worry if you forget to use your cream at the right time. When you remember, start using the product again as you did before. If you have any further questions on the use of this medicine, ask your pharmacist.

- If you use too much (overdose)

In the rare event that you use more than you should or accidentally swallow any of this product, seek medical advice.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist before using Aqua Cream.

Avoid contact with the eyes. Upon accidental contact, rinse the affected area with clean water. Aqua Cream is for external use only.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop taking the medicine unless advised by your doctor.

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.

Do not give Aqua Cream to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

Hypersensitivity reaction such as contact dermatitis (reddening and irritation of skin) may occur with the hydroxybenzoates preservatives (parabens).

If irritation occurs, discontinue use temporarily.

Side effects

Like all medicines, this medicine can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

If you continue to get discomfort when you have been applying Aqua Cream, wash the cream off and stop using it for few days. If the effects still persist or are severe when you start using it again, stop using the product altogether and seek the advice of your doctor or pharmacist. Side effects of cream base are rare when used in topical preparations.

Storage and Disposal of Aqua Cream

- Storage

Keep this medicine out of the sight and reach of children. Store in a dry place below 30°C. Store the closed container away from direct heat and light.

- Disposal

Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer use. These measures will help protect the environment.

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date which is stated on the tube and carton.
