## What Dermoplex Antifungal Cream is used for

Treatment of fungal infections such as athlete's foot, ringworm, tinea versicolor (white spot) and jock (groin) itch.

## How Dermoplex Antifungal Cream works

Dermoplex Antifungal Cream contains the active ingredient Tolnaftate.

Tolnaftate is broad spectrum in the treatment of the skin with fungal infection.

Ask your pharmacist or doctor if you have any questions about this medicine.

## Before you use Dermoplex Antifungal Cream

### - When you must not use it

Do not use this medicine if you have an allergy to:

- Tolnaftate
- Any of the other ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date printed on the pack or if the packaging is torn or shows signs of tampering. If it has expired or is damaged, return it to your pharmacist for disposal.

If you are not sure whether you should start using this medicine, talk to your doctor.

### - Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you have allergies to any other medicines, foods, preservatives or dyes.

### - Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Some medicines and Dermoplex Antifungal Cream may interfere with each other.

Speak to your doctor or pharmacist before taking this product with other medicines.

Your doctor or pharmacist has more information on medicines to be careful with or to avoid while using Dermoplex Antifungal Cream.

## How to use Dermoplex Antifungal Cream

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor or pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

### - How much to use

Apply gently to the affected area two to three times daily, continuing for fourteen days after symptoms have disappeared.

If symptoms do not go away, talk to your doctor.

### - When to use it

Use Dermoplex Antifungal Cream as your doctor has prescribed.

### - How long to use it

Continue using your medicine for as long as your doctor tells you.

### - If you forget to use it

If you forget to apply the medicine, you can apply it as soon as you remember.

### - If you use too much (overdose)

When used as recommended, overdosing with Dermoplex Antifungal Cream is rare.

## While you are using Dermoplex Antifungal Cream

### - Things you must do

Always follow your doctor's instructions carefully.

Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.

### - Things you must not do

Do not use Dermoplex Antifungal Cream to treat any other complaints unless your doctor tells you to.

Do not give your medicine to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

### - Things to be careful of

Dermoplex Antifungal Cream is for external usage only.

Avoid contact with eyes.

## Side effects

All medicines can have side effects. Sometimes they are serious, most of the time they are not. You may need medical attention if you get some of the side effects.

Do not be alarmed by the following lists of side effects. You may not experience any of them.

Ask your doctor or pharmacist to answer any questions you may have. Most people will not have problems, but some may get some of these:

- Skin reactions – irritation and pruritus
- Contact dermatitis (redness and swelling of the skin)

If any of the side effect becomes severe, or you experience any side effect not listed here, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

**Storage and Disposal of Dermoplex Antifungal Cream**

- *Storage*

Keep your medicine in the original container. If you take it out of its original container it may not keep well.

Keep your medicine in a dry place where the temperature stays below 30°C. Protect from light.

Do not store Dermoplex Antifungal Cream or any other medicine in the bathroom or near a sink. Do not leave it on a window sill or in the car. Heat and dampness can destroy some medicines.

Keep Dermoplex Antifungal Cream away from children.

- *Disposal*

If your doctor tells you to stop taking this medicine or if the expiry date has passed, ask your pharmacist what to do with any medicine that is left.
