What Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream is used for

Minor cuts and burns, nappy rashes, blisters, sunburn, insect bites and stings

How Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream works

Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream contains cetrimide, an antiseptic that helps to prevent infection and aids healing.

Before you use Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream

- When you must not take it

Do not use this medicine if you have an allergy to:

- Cetrimide
- any of the other ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date printed on the pack or if the packaging is torn or shows signs of tampering. If it has expired or is damaged, return it to your pharmacist for disposal.

If you are not sure whether you should start using this medicine, talk to your doctor.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you have allergies to any other medicines, foods, preservatives or dyes.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Some medicines and Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream may interfere with each other.

Speak to your pharmacist or doctor before taking this product with other medicines.

Your doctor or pharmacist has more information on medicines to be careful with or to avoid while using Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream.

How to use Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor or pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet.

If you do not understand the instructions, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- How much to use

Apply over the affected area 2-3 times daily. If symptoms do not go away, talk to your doctor

- When to use it

Use Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream as your doctor has prescribed.

- How long to use it

Continue using your medicine for as long as your doctor tells you.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to apply the medicine, you can apply it as soon as you remember.

- If you use too much (overdose)

When used as recommended, overdosing with Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream is rare.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Always follow your doctor's instructions carefully.

Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.

- Things you must not do

Do not use Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream to treat any other complaints unless your doctor tells you to.

Do not give your medicine to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

- Be careful when driving or operating machinery until you know how Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream affects you.

- For use on the skin only.

- Avoid contact with eyes and use in body cavities.

Side effects

All medicines can have side effects. Sometimes they are serious, most of the time they are not. You may need medical attention if you get some of the side effects.

Do not be alarmed by the following lists of side effects. You may not experience any of them.

Ask your doctor or pharmacist to answer any questions you may have. Most people will not have problems, but some may get some of these:

- Skin irritation
- Occasional sensitisation on the skin

If any side effect becomes severe, or you notice any side effect not listed here, please tell your pharmacist or doctor.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Monitoring by visiting the website www.npra.gov.my [Consumers→ Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and Disposal of Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream

- Storage

Keep your medicine in the original container. If you take it out of its original container it may not keep well. Keep container tightly closed.

Keep your medicine in a dry place where the temperature stays below 30°C. Protect from light.

Do not store Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream or any other medicine in the bathroom or near a sink. Do not leave it on a window sill or in the car. Heat and dampness can destroy some medicines.

Keep Dermoplex Antiseptic Cream away from children.

- Disposal

If your doctor tells you to stop taking this medicine or if the expiry date has passed, ask your pharmacist what to do with any medicine that is left.
