What AQUACARE CREAM is used for

AQUACARE CREAM used as an emollient for the relief of the symptoms of dry skin conditions and as soap-substitute for skin washing.

How AQUACARE CREAM works

AQUACARE CREAM ingredients have emollient properties that soften or soothe the skin.

Before you use AQUACARE CREAM

When you must not use it

If you are allergic to any of the ingredients.

- Before you start to use it

- Inform your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or using any other medication at the same time.

- Check the seal is not broken before first use. If it is, do not use the cream.

- Taking other medicines

- Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have taken recently any other medicines.

How to use AQUACARE CREAM

- How much to use

Apply to the affected area as required or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- When to use it

Treatment should start as early as possible.

- How long to use it

You need to apply the medication as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to take it

Reapply as you need.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If anyone accidentally swallows some of the cream, talk to a pharmacist or doctor.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

- Always wash your hands before and after you use the cream.
- Inform your doctor or pharmacist if you develop any allergic reactions.

- Things you must not do
Do not share your medication with anyone.

- Things to be careful of
If sensitization develops, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Side Effects

Most people will not have problems, but some may get some of these: Occasional allergic reaction (e.g stinging, burning, itching and redness).

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.moh.gov.my [Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and disposal of AQUACARE CREAM

- Storage

- Keep container tightly closed.
- Store below 30 °C.
- Protect from heat, moisture and light.
- Keep medicines out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines that are no longer required.
