## What Medicare Medimax Cream is used for

Medicare Medimax Cream is a non-prescription skin product.

It is useful for temporary relief of pain associated with musculoskeletal soreness and discomfort.

## How Medicare Medimax Cream works

Medicare Medimax Cream contains methyl salicylate and menthol which act as counterirritants (causing the skin to feel cool and then warm). It also contains eucalyptus oil which has rubefacient action (causing increased blood flow and redness of the skin). These feelings on the skin distract you from the pains in your muscles, joints, and tendons.

## Before you use Medicare Medimax Cream

### - When you must not use it

If you are allergic to any of the ingredients at the end of this leaflet.

This product is not recommended in children under 2 years of age. Caution must be exercised when older children are treated.

### - Before you start to use it

It should not be applied to broken or inflamed skin or near the eyes or mucous membranes.

### - Taking other medicines

This product contains methyl salicylate and when applied or rub on to the skin, can be absorbed through the skin into the blood, for patients taking warfarin, excessive application to the skin for muscle or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding.

## How to use Medicare Medimax Cream

Always use Medicare Medimax Cream exactly as your doctor has told you.

### - How much to use

Apply sparingly to the affected parts and surrounding skin areas twice or three times daily.

### - When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist. Repeated applications may be administered as needed.

### - How long to use it

Continue taking Medicare Medimax Cream for as long as your doctor recommends.

### - If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

### - If you use too much (overdose)

Overdose from topical application is very rare. If you have accidentally ingested or if you think anyone else may have ingested Medicare Medimax Cream, contact doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital.

## While you are using it

### - Things you must do

Talk to your pharmacist or doctor if your symptoms do not improve. Your pharmacist or doctor will assess your condition and decide if you should continue to take the medicine.

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Medicare Medimax Cream.

### - Things you must not do

Discontinue use if burning sensation or rash develops or conditions persist.

Do not give Medicare Medimax Cream to anyone else; even they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

Do not stop taking the medicine unless advised by your doctor.

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

### - Things to be careful of

Medicare Medimax Cream is for external use only.

You are advised to follow instruction as given by your doctor or pharmacist.

## Side Effects

Like all medicines, Medicare Medimax Cream can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Medicare Medimax Cream are well-tolerated except for occasional allergic reactions, skin rash and angioneurotic oedema may occur is susceptible person.

## Storage and Disposal of Medicare Medimax Cream

### - Storage

Keep out of reach of children. Store below 30°C. Protect from light and freezing.

### - Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
