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#### What Reparil ® Gel N is used for

Reparil Gel N is used for the treatment of sprains, bruises, crush injuries, and swelling of a tendon (tendonitis). It can be used to treat neck pain and lower back pain (lumbago or sciatica). Reparil Gel N can also be used to treat vein swelling or injury and varicose veins.

## How Reparil ® Gel N works

Reparil-Gel N contains aescin and diethylamine salicylate which reduce inflammation. Aescin also improves blood flow problems.

## Before you use Reparil® Gel N

- When you must not use it Reparil ® Gel N should not be applied on broken skin, mucous membranes or skin area that is exposed to radiotherapy.
- <u>Before you start to use it</u>
  This product is for external use only.
  Do not apply to wounds or damaged skin.
- *Taking other medicine*Please inform your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines.

## How to use Reparil® Gel N

- How much to use

Spread a thin layer of the gel onto the skin of the affected area once daily or more frequently. It is not necessary to rub the gel into the skin.

## When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

## - How long to use it

Continue using  $Repartl \otimes Gel N$  for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as you remember.
Then continue using it at your usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)
It is advisable for you to inform your doctor if you applied too much Reparal Gel N.

## While you are using it

- Things you must do
  Inform your doctor of all the
  medications you are taking.
- <u>Things you must not do</u>
  Do not allow the gel to come into contact with the eyes.
- Things to be careful of
  Seek advice from your doctor or
  pharmacist if your condition
  worsens or does not improve.

## **Side Effects**

Like all medicines, *Reparil* ® *Gel N* can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Reparil <sup>®</sup> Gel N might cause skin irritation, redness or swelling, burning or stinging sensation.

Dizziness and nausea might occur in rare cases.
