

CANEZIN CREAM

Clotrimazole (1% w/w)

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What Canezin Cream is used for

It is indicated for the treatment of skin infections due to dermatophytes, yeast, moulds, and other fungi.

How Canezin Cream works

Clotrimazole is the active ingredient of Canezin Cream. Clotrimazole is an antifungal agent that may act by preventing the growth of fungus.

Before you use Canezin Cream

-When you must not use it

If you are allergic (hypersensitive) to Clotrimazole or any of the other ingredients of Canezin Cream.

-Before you start to use it

You must tell your doctor if:

- You have allergies to any medicine which you have taken previously to treat your current condition.
- If you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine.

-Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Canezin Cream

-How much to use

Clotrimazole cream is applied topically.

-When to use it

Apply two or three times daily or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Use Canezin Cream for 2 to 4 weeks or according to the duration that the doctor recommends.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to apply it.

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have apply too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

Overdose symptoms such as dizziness, nausea or vomiting may occur.

While you are using it

-Things you must do

- Use your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.
- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Canezin Cream.
- Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medication.
- Contact your doctor if your symptoms worsen or they do not improve after 4 weeks of treatment.

-Things you must not do

- Do not stop using the medicine unless advised by your doctor.
- Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not give Canezin Cream to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

For external use. Do not swallow it.

Side Effects

Like all medicines, Canezin Cream can have side effects, although not everybody gets them. The following side effects may happen with this medicine:

- Skin rash
- Hives
- Blistering
- Burning
- Itching
- Peeling
- Redness
- Stinging
- Swelling
- Other sign of skin irritation not present before therapy

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers →Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and Disposal of Canezin Cream

-Storage

Do not use after the expiry date stated on the tube end. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

Store below 30°C in well-closed containers. Protect from light, heat, moisture and freezing.

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

-Ingredients

- Active Ingredient
Each gram contain Clotrimazole 10mg

- Inactive ingredients
The other ingredients are Propylene Glycol, mineral oil heavy, Benzyl Alcohol, Cetyl Alcohol, Stearic Acid, Polyoxyl 40 Stearate and Whitening Bouquet
