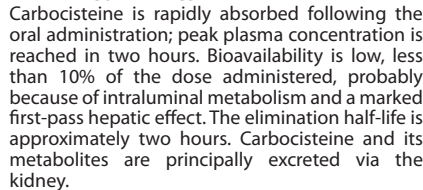
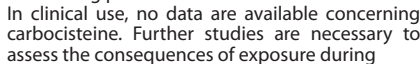

- in elderly subjects presenting with:
 - increased sensitivity to orthostatic hypotension, dizziness and sedation
 - Chronic constipation (risk of paralytic ileus)
 - Possible prostate hypertrophy;
- in subjects with certain cardiovascular disorders, because of the tachycardic and hypotensive



Related to the presence of promethazine:
The pharmacological characteristics of the substance are responsible of more or less severe adverse effects, which may or may not be related to the dose (see PHARMACODYNAMICS)
Neurovegetative effects:
- Sedation or drowsiness, more marked at the beginning of the treatment
- Anticholinergic effects, such as dryness of the
