What is Cafuroid used for

For the treatment of:

-Symptoms related to venolymphatic insufficiency (a condition where the flow of blood through the veins is inadequate, causing blood to pool in the legs), such as heavy legs, pain, early morning restless leg.

- Functional symptoms related to acute hemorrhoidal attack. Hemorrhoids are vascular structures in the anal canal. In normal condition, they are cushions that help with stool control. They become a disease when swollen or inflamed.

How Cafuroid works

Micronized purified flavonoid fraction containing Diosmin and Hesperidin. Diosmin is synthesized from Hesperidin. Hesperidin is a flavonoid found in citrus fruits.

Cafuroid is used to treat and protect blood vessel by reducing the distention of blood vessel and the slowdown in the flow of blood. It also increases the permeability and strengthens the resistance of capillary (fine branching of blood vessels).

Before you use Cafuroid

When you must not to use it

Do not use Cafuroid if:

- You are allergic to Diosmin or Hesperidin.

Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you:

- are pregnant or plan to pregnant
- are breast-feeding.
- have hemorrhoids.

Taking other medicines

- Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have recently taken any other medicines. This includes any medicines which you have bought without a prescription.

How to use Cafuroid

How much to use

Usual dose

2 tablets daily. 1 tablet at mid-day and 1 tablet in the evening at meal times.

Acute Hemorrhoidal Attack

First 4 days- 6 tablets daily

Subsequent 3 days- 4 tablets daily.

When to use it

Use only when necessary. Can be taken with food.

How long to use it

- Follow the recommendation from your doctor or pharmacist.
- Ask your doctor or pharmacist before prolonged using Cafuroid.

If you forget to use it

In case you miss a dose, do not double the dose the next time you take it. Double the dose may lead to overdose.

If you use too much (overdose)

No specific overdosage symptoms have been reported.

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using Cafuroid

Things you must do

- Cafuroid is for oral use only.
- Swallow slowly with water.

Things you must not do

- Do not take Cafuroid if not necessary.
- Do not exceed the stated dose.
- Do not chew the tablet.

Things to be careful of

- Please always consult your doctor or pharmacist before using Cafuroid, especially when there is a known hypersensitivity to Diosmin and Hesperidin.

Side effects

May cause minor gastrointestinal effects such as diarrhoea, indigestion, nausea and vomiting. Neurovegetative disorders have been reported with the use of micronized

purified flavonoid fraction. Neurovegetative is disturbance of a person's nerve functions which are necessary to maintain life.

If you experience any symptoms persistently for more than 7 days, please consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Storage and disposal of Cafuroid

Storage

Store below 30°C.

Keep out of reach of children.

The expiry date of this product is indicated on the packaging.

Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.

Diosmin and Hesperidin

Microcrystalline Cellulose, Povidone, Purified Talc, Sodium Starch Glycolate, Magnesium Stearate, Hydroxypropyl Methylcellulose Compound Mix, Colour Pigmen Red, Colour Quinoline and Purified Water.
