What *Xynoz Tablet* is used for
Xynoz Tablet relieves symptoms of allergic reaction. These symptoms include sneezing, runny, blocked and itchy nose.

Xynoz Tablet is also used to relieve the symptoms of a skin allergic reaction (urticaria). These symptoms include itching and hives.

How *Xynoz Tablet* works
Xynoz Tablet is an antiallergy medicine that does not make you drowsy. It helps control your allergic reaction and its symptoms.

Before you use *Xynoz Tablet*

- When you must not use it

- ☐ Do not use *Xynoz Tablet* if you are allergic (hypersensitive) to desloratadine, to any of the other ingredients of *Xynoz Tablet* or to loratadine.

- Before you start to use it

- ☐ Talk to your doctor or pharmacist before taking *Xynoz Tablet* if you have medical or familial history of seizures.
- ☐ Efficacy and safety of *Xynoz Tablet* in children under 12 years of age have not been established.

Pregnancy and breast-feeding

- ☐ Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking any medicine during pregnancy and breast-feeding.
- ☐ If you are pregnant or nursing a baby, taking *Xynoz Tablet* is not recommended.

- Taking other medicines

There are no known interactions of *Xynoz Tablet* with other medicines.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking, have recently taken or might take any other medicines.

Taking *Xynoz Tablet* with food and drink

Xynoz Tablet may be taken with or without a meal.

How to use *Xynoz Tablet*

- How much to use

Adults and adolescents (12 years of age and older): take one tablet once a day.

- When to use it

Swallow the tablet whole with water, with or without food.

- How long to use it

Continue taking *Xynoz Tablet* for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to take your dose on time, take it as soon as possible, then go back to your regular dosing schedule. Do not take a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Take *Xynoz Tablet* only as it is prescribed for you. No serious problems are expected with accidental overdose. However, if you take more *Xynoz Tablet* than

you were told to, contact your doctor or pharmacist.

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using *Xynoz Tablet*

- Things you must do

- ☐ Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.
- ☐ Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

- Things you must not do

- ☐ Do not stop taking the medicine unless advised by your doctor.
- ☐ Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.
- ☐ Do not give *Xynoz Tablet* to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

- ☐ **Driving and using machines**
 - At the recommended dose, *Xynoz Tablet* is not expected to cause you to be drowsy or less alert. However, very rarely some people experience drowsiness, which may affect their ability to drive or use machines.

Side Effects

Like all medicines, *Xynoz Tablet* can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. However, fatigue, dry mouth and

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headache were frequently reported.

The common side effect on paediatric is headache. Other than that, are arrhythmia (irregular pattern of heartbeat), *bradycardia* (slow heart rate), abnormal behaviour and aggression but very rarely reported.

If any of the side effects gets serious, or if you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npa.moh.gov.my (Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicine (ConSERF)/Vaccines (AEFI)).

Storage and Disposal of Xynoz Tablet

- Storage

- ☐ Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- ☐ Store below 30 °C. Store in the original package.
- ☐ Do not take the tablet after the expiry date shown on the pack and blisters.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

Xynoz Tablet 5 mg film-coated tablet is a light blue round tablet, marked with 'D' on one side and plain on the other.

Xynoz Tablet 5mg is available in the pack size of 1 x 10's & 10 x 10's tablets.

Desloratadine 5mg
- ☐ Inactive ingredients:
Dibasic calcium phosphate dihydrate, microcrystalline cellulose, pregelatinized starch, talc powder, purified water and opadry II blue.
