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What Axcel Urea Cream is used for

Axcel Urea Cream is used in ichthyosis and hyperkeratotic skin disorders (dry, scaling and itchy skin conditions) such as:

- Contact irritant dermatitis (housewife skin inflammation) which is caused by detergent, shampoo, highly alkaline soap or chemicals.
- Acute and chronic allergic eczemas.
- Infantile eczema.
- 'Winter itch' and 'winter chapping'.

How Axcel Urea Cream works

Urea is claimed to have anaesthetic, bactericidal (kills bacteria) and keratolytic (peeling) properties. These properties are probably due to its hydration effects.

Before you use Axcel Urea Cream

- When you must not use it

Do not take Axcel Urea Cream if:

- You are applying it to inflamed skin or exudative lesion.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if:

- You are having allergic to any medicines.

If the above situations apply to you, talk to your doctor who will decide what to do.

- Taking other medicines

You should tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines.

It may still be all right for you to use Axcel Urea Cream and your doctor

will be able to decide what is suitable for you.

How to use Axcel Urea Cream

How much to use

This cream is for external use only.

- Apply to the affected area as required.

- When to use it

Your doctor will decide when it is appropriate for you to take Axcel Urea Cream according to the type of condition you have.

- How long to use it

- Follow any recommendations and advises from your doctor or pharmacist on how long you need to take your medicine.

- If you forget to use it

- If you forget to use your cream at a certain time, use it as soon as you remember. However, if it is nearly time for your next application, skip the missed application.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If, by mistake on a few occasions you use more than you should, do not worry. If you apply a lot or a lot is accidentally swallowed, it could make you ill. However, accidental consumption of Axcel Urea Cream may cause irritation to the gastric lining. Nausea and vomiting may occur. Talk to your doctor or go to the hospital as soon as possible.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

- Discuss with your doctor or pharmacist the dos' and don'ts' while using this cream.
- Tell your doctor if unexpectedly you need to take or use any other medicines.
- Use the Axcel Urea Cream according to the recommended direction and duration.
- Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you experience any side effects that are not listed in this leaflet.

- Things you must not do

- Do not use your Axcel Urea Cream more than the suggested frequency per day, as recommended by your doctor or pharmacist.

- Things to be careful of

- Not to be taken orally.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Axcel Urea Cream can cause side effects although not everybody gets them. You are advised to consult doctor/pharmacist for further information. The following side effects have been reported:

- Stinging.
- Burning sensation.

Storage and disposal of Axcel Urea Cream

- Storage

Keep Axcel Urea Cream out of reach of children.

Store below 30°C, keep container well closed and protect from light.

- Disposal

Do not use Axcel Urea Cream after the expiry date which is stated on the carton.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
