

PRINCI-B FORT TABLET

Thiamine mononitrate/Pyridoxine hydrochloride/Cyanocobalamin (250mg/250mg/1mg)

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What Princi-B Fort is used for

Nerve disorders in which high dose vitamin B complex play a role. They include:

- nerve inflammation
- nerve pain
- nerve damage that is caused by diabetes
- nerve changes due to pregnancy and oral contraceptives
- recovery after an illness or injury

How Princi-B Fort works

Vitamin B helps promote proper nerve function.

Before you use Princi-B Fort

- When you must not use it

Past history of allergy to cobalamins or any other ingredients listed at the end of the leaflet.

Known intolerance to Vitamin B1.

- Before you start to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

- Taking other medicines

Vitamin B6 decreases the effects of levodopa, so please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have recently taken levodopa or any other medicines.

How to use Princi-B Fort

- How much to use

Therapeutic dose:

2-3 tablets daily.

Maintenance dose:

1 tablet daily.

- When to use it

Princi-B Fort should be swallowed whole, during or immediately after meals.

- How long to use it

You should take for 7-10 days or check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

- If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Princi-B Fort.

- Things you must not do

Do not take the tablet on an empty stomach.

- Things to be careful of

Driving and using machines

This medicine may affect your ability to drive or use machines. If the tablets make you feel sick, dizzy or tired, or give you a headache, do not drive or use machines and contact your doctor immediately.

Side effects

Allergic hypersensitivity reactions have occurred rarely following the administration of vitamin B12 products.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website nptra.gov.my [Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)]

Storage and Disposal of Princi-B Fort

- Storage

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

Store below 25°C.

Do not use after the expiry date which is stated on the carton.

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The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste.

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.

These measures will help to protect the environment.
