

YUCOMY CREAM

Ketoconazole (20mg)

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What YUCOMY CREAM is used for

Treatment of skin fungal infection such as athlete's foot, jock itch and white spots.

How YUCOMY CREAM works

Ketoconazole is a broad spectrum antifungal agent which works by killing the fungus that causes the infections.

Before you use YUCOMY CREAM

-When you must not take it

If you are allergic to any components in YUCOMY CREAM. It cannot be used for eye infection.

-Before you start to take it

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, breast feeding or use other medicine.

-Taking other medicines

Avoid using other medications on the areas you treat with YUCOMY CREAM unless your doctor or pharmacist tells you to.

How to take YUCOMY CREAM

-How much to take

Apply a thin film to the affected skin area once daily.

-When to take it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to take it

Apply on lesion without interruption until one week after the lesion has completely disappeared.

-If you forgot to take it

If you forget to use the cream, apply the cream as soon as possible and then continue the rest of the treatment as usual.

-If you take too much (overdose)

Exaggerated use might bring on local irritation and erythema.

While you are using YUCOMY CREAM

-Things you must do

Always use this cream exactly as described on the label or as your doctor or pharmacist has told you. Promptly discontinue application of YUCOMY CREAM if found sensitivity or irritation after using it.

-Things you must not do

Contact it with your eyes or keep it at the place that can be reached by children.

-Things to be careful of

Please get the advice from the doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

-Side effects

Cases of irritation, itching and stinging have been reported as adverse reaction in patient treated with topical ketoconazole cream.

YUCOMY CREAM may cause agitation, dry mouth and headache. Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you experience any other side effects.

Storage and Disposal of YUCOMY CREAM

-Storage

Keep in a tight container. Store at temperature below 30°C. Protect from light and moisture.

-Disposal

YUCOMY CREAM should be disposed when your doctor or pharmacist tells you to stop taking this tablet or it has passed the expiry date. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose medicines that are no longer required.
