Fluconazole 150mg

What is in this leaflet

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What FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE is used for

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE is used to treat and prevent cryptococcal infections (eg. brain infection), candidiasis (eg. vagina & tongue infection) and fungus infection, specifically in patients with impaired immunity.

How FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE works

Fluconazole is an antifungal agent which inhibits fungal sterol synthesis, thus impair growth and survival of fungus and certain microorganisms.

Before you use FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE

When you must not take it

Do not take FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE if you have allergy towards any components in FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE. Avoid taking FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Before you start to take it

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are allergic to any medicines or if you have any other health related problems.

Inform your doctor if you have such conditions:

Pregnant or planning to become pregnant
FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE may cause harm to your unborn baby. You should not take FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE while you are pregnant unless your doctor has told you

to. Inform your doctor if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant.

If you are a woman of child-bearing potential, avoid becoming pregnant during treatment. Use effective contraception during treatment and for 1 week after treatment.

Breast-feeding

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE is excreted in human breast milk, hence its use in nursing mother is not recommended. However, breast-feeding may be maintained if you took a single dose of FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE 150mg. Breast-feeding is not recommended after a high dose (more than 150mg) or repeated use of FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE.

Taking other medicines

Seek for your doctor or pharmacist advice if you intended to use FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE together with other medication. Besides, you must also inform them about all the medicines you are taking, including those without a prescription.

How to take FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE

How much to take

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE should be taken according to instruction of doctor or pharmacist.

When to take it

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE should be taken according to instruction of doctor or pharmacist.

How long to take it

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE should be taken as your doctor advised you to do so.

If you forgot to take it

If you miss a dose of FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE, take the missed dose as soon as you remember. However, if it is approaching time for the next dose, do not double the dose to make up for the forgotten dose, unless advised by your health care provider. Do not take a double dose to make up for a missed one.

If you take too much (overdose)

Seek medical attention immediately.

While you are using FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE

Things you must do

Follow your doctor's instruction when you are taking FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE.

Things you must not do

Do not stop taking this medicine or change the dosing regimen without instruction from your doctor. Do not give this medication to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

Things to be careful of

Patients who are taking medication(s) other than FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE should consult with doctor or pharmacist. Promptly stop taking FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE if skin conditions such as rash, painful blister, skin lesions occurs.

Side effects

Possible side effects of FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE are nausea, abdominal pain, diarrhea, flatulence and rash.

Storage and Disposal of FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE

Storage

Store below 30°C, protect from light & moisture.

Disposal

FUKOLE[®] CAPSULE should be disposed when your doctor or pharmacist tells you to stop taking this tablet or it has passed the expiry date. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose medicines that are no longer required.
