Diosmin / Hesperidin (450 mg / 50 mg)

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What Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet is used for

It is used to reduce symptoms of chronic venous insufficiency in the legs (visible varicose veins under the skin) causing heavy or tired legs, pain, swelling, night cramps. It is also used in treating both long-term and sudden flare-ups of hemorrhoids (swollen veins in the rectum).

How Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet works

This product contains bioflavonoids that are natural compounds from citrus fruits called Diosmin and Hesperidin. They work by supporting the veins, reducing swelling and inflammation, and improving blood flow, which can relieve symptoms like heavy legs, pain, varicose veins and hemorrhoids.

Before you use Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet

-When you must not use it

If you are allergic towards Diosmin and Hesperidin, or any other ingredients in this product (listed in Product Description).

-Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and Lactation

If you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy, or breastfeeding during treatment, you should not take Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet unless your doctor tells you to. Your doctor will consider about the potential benefits and risks of your therapy to you and your child.

-Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet

-How much to use

For chronic venous insufficiency (poor blood circulation in the legs):

Take 1 tablet, 2 times per day.

For acute hemorrhoidal attacks (sudden hemorrhoid flare-ups):

Take 3 tablets, 2 times per day for 4 days, then 2 tablets, 2 times per day for the next 3 days, and after that, 2 tablets per day.

For chronic hemorrhoidal disease (long-term hemorrhoid treatment):

Take 2 tablets per day.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist. It can be taken with food.

-How long to use it

Use Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet for the duration that the doctor or pharmacist recommends.

-If you forget to use it

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

-Things you must do

Tell all doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medication.

-Things you must not do

Do not stop taking this medicine or change the dosing regimen without instruction from your doctor.

Do not give Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Driving and using machines

This medicine may affect your ability to drive or use machines. If this medicine makes you feel sick, dizzy, tired, or gives you a headache do not drive or use machines and contact your doctor immediately.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine.

Only minor side effects such as gastrointestinal problems and effects on sleep, appetite, or energy levels have been reported.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and Disposal of Homecare[®] Davmorid[®] Film Coated Tablet

-Storage

- Keep in a tight container.
- Store at temperature below 30°C.
- Protect from light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
