

SHINADEX EYE DROPS

Chloramphenicol 5mg/ml, Dexamethasone Sodium Phosphate 1mg/ml

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What SHINADEX Eye Drops is used for

It is used to treat allergic, infection (non viral) and inflammation condition of eye components (cornea, iris, sclera, ciliary body, and conjunctiva.) It can also be used in postoperative management of cataract, glaucoma and strabismus (a condition in which the eyes are not properly aligned with each other.)

How SHINADEX Eye Drops works

SHINADEX is an ophthalmic solution that consists of an antibiotic (chloramphenicol) and a corticosteroid (dexamethasone sodium phosphate). They work together to kill bacteria and inhibit the process of inflammation.

Before you use SHINADEX Eye Drops

- When you must not apply it

You must not take SHINADEX if you have any injuries and ulcerating conditions of cornea, infection of conjunctiva and eyelids, tendency to glaucoma as well as fungal and tuberculous eye infection.

- Before you start to apply it

Tell your doctor if you are using any other medicines or you have any other health problems.

- Taking other medicines

SHINADEX may cause unwanted effect if used together with other medicine such as other ophthalmic antibiotics, drugs that affects blood forming system, certain antidiabetic drugs and others. Tell your doctor if you are applying any other medication.

How to apply SHINADEX Eye Drops

- How much to apply

One drop, 3 to 5 times daily, into the lower eyelid for up to 10 days.

- When to apply it

SHINADEX eye drops should be applied according to doctor's instruction.

- How long to apply it

SHINADEX should be applied according to doctor's instruction.

- If you forgot to apply it

If you miss a dose of SHINADEX and you are applying it regularly, apply it as soon as possible. If several hours have passed or if it is nearing time for the next dose, do not double the dose to catch up, unless advised by your health care provider. Do not apply 2 doses at once.

- If you apply too much

Quickly seek for medical attention if you think that you or anyone else has applied too much SHINADEX.

While you are using SHINADEX Eye Drops

- Things you must do

Apply the eye drops according to doctor's instruction.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop applying this medicine or change the dosing regimen without instruction of your doctor. Do not give SHINADEX to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

Should be used with caution in children, lactating mothers and pregnant lady. SHINADEX should not be administered in the last trimester of pregnancy and nursing.

Side effects

Chloramphenicol can cause anemia aplitic. It may also cause a reversible rise in intraocular pressure after several weeks' application. Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you experience any other side effects.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine.

Storage and Disposal of SHINADEX Eye Drops

- Storage

Before & After Opening:
Store at temperature between 2°C and 8°C.

- Disposal

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you stop applying the eye drops or the eye drops have passed their expiry date. Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
