

ALLERGO-COMOD[®] EYE DROPS

Sodium Cromoglycate (20 mg/ml)

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What Allergo-COMOD[®] is used for

Allergo-COMOD[®] is used for treatment of allergic eye conditions such as hayfever and conjunctivitis.

How Allergo-COMOD[®] works

Allergo-COMOD[®] contains an antiallergic agent which acts by preventing the release of the natural substances in your body that can cause an allergic reaction.

Before you use Allergo-COMOD[®]

-When you must not use it

Do not use if you have hypersensitivity to sodium cromoglycate or any ingredients of the product.

Contact lenses should not be worn during treatment with Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops.

-Before you start to use it

Inform your doctor if you are pregnant or breastfeeding. Although there is no evidence of damaging effects to the fetus, Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops is not recommended for use the first three months of pregnancy

-Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Allergo-COMOD[®]

- Remove the cap covering the nozzle.

- Tilt your head back.
Retract the lower lid with a finger.
Gently squeeze out one drop onto the exposed surface of the lower lid avoiding any contact of the bottle with eye or skin. Close the bottle carefully.

-How much to use

For adults and children 4 years and above:

The usual dose is 1 drop four times daily.

Safety and effectiveness in children below 4 years of age has not been established.

-When to use it

Use four times daily or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Use the medicine for the duration that your doctor recommends.

Do not stop treatment with Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops after symptoms improve. Rather use continuously until you are no longer in contact with the allergen (pollen, house dust, mold, etc.).

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Overdosing or intoxications are not to be expected when Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops are used properly. Until now, no cases of intoxications are known.

While you are using it

-Things you must do

Use your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops.

-Things you must not do

Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Immediately after applying Allergo-COMOD[®] eye drops vision will be blurred for a short time which subsequently impair reaction time. Do not drive or use machines until your vision recovered.

Side effects

Like all medicines, AllergoCOMOD[®] eye drops can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

In rare cases, temporary burning sensation, sensation of having "sand in eye", increase of blood flow and eye irritation have been reported.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine

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Storage and Disposal of Allergo-COMOD[®]

-Storage

Use before the expiration date (imprinted on the packaging carton).

Do not store above 30°C.

Do not use Allergo-COMOD[®] longer than 12 weeks after the bottle has been opened.

-Disposal

Do not throw away medicines via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer use. These measures will help protect the environment.

Product Description

-What it looks like

Allergo-COMOD[®] is a clear, colourless to slightly yellow eye drop filled in a 10ml dropper plastic bottle.

-Ingredients

-Active ingredient

Each ml contains 20 mg of sodium cromoglycate.

-Inactive ingredient:

The other ingredients are disodium edetate, sorbitol, water for injections.

Note: Allergo-COMOD[®] is preservative free.
