What *KEBANON plaster* is used for

Traumatic inflammation of muscles, sprains and strains, and relief of symptoms of muscular pain.

How *KEBANON plaster* works

KEBANON plaster belongs to a group of medicines called Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs). These reduce inflammation and relieve pain.

Before you use *KEBANON plaster*

- When you must not use it

KEBANON plaster must not be used in patients with:

- history of hypersensitivity to ketoprofen
- aspirin induced asthma (asthma induced by NSAIDs) or its previous history.

- Pregnancy and lactation

Do not take *KEBANON plaster* if you are pregnant, trying to get pregnant or think you may be pregnant.

Do not take *KEBANON plaster* if you are breast-feeding. Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking any medicine.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use *KEBANON plaster*

Always take *KEBANON plaster* exactly as your doctor or pharmacist has told you. Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure

- How much to use

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

Take off thin backing paper and apply (paste) to affected part twice daily, or upon advise of doctors.

- When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Continue taking *KEBANON plaster* for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Overdose is unlikely to be caused by topical administration. However, if they occur, contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell all the doctors and pharmacists treating you that you are taking *KEBANON plaster*.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

- Things you must not do

- Avoid if you have exudative dermatosis (severe skin sores with pus), eczema, sores and infected skin lesions or broken skin.
- Do not apply to the eye or mucous membrane
- Do not use for occlusive dressing
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.
- Do not give *KEBANON plaster* to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

- Carefully applied if you have bronchial asthma.
- Temporary pain or irritation of skin may occur.
- If rash occur, remove plaster immediately.
- Do not expose treated skin to sunlight
- Safety in children is not established yet.

Side effects

Like all medicines, *KEBANON plaster* can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Skin: occasionally redness, rash, itch, dryness & irritation, swelling and sensitive to sunlight may occur. If symptoms are serious, treatment should be discontinued.

Storage and Disposal of *KEBANON plaster*

- Storage

Keep out of the reach of children.

Storage in a light-resistant and a tight container below 30°C.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

Plaster (7x10cm²) of peach colored non-woven fabric coated transparent adhesive substance and covered its solid surface with a thin paper.
