What UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP is used for

UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP is for topical use. It acts as an emollient for the symptomatic relief of dry skin condition and act as soap for skin washing.

How UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP works

UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP work by smoothen, soothes and moisture the dry skin.

Before you use UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP

-When you must not use it

Tell your doctor before using UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP if you have an allergic or hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients in the product.

-Pregnancy and lactation

The safety of aqueous cream during pregnancy and lactation has not been established but is not considered to constitute a hazard during these periods.

-Before you start to use it

This product came without prescription. Tell your doctor or pharmacist before using this product.

-Taking other medicines

Some medicines and UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP may interfere with each other over the skin.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or using any other medicines,

including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP

-How much to use

Apply a thin layer over affected area 2 to 3 times daily or as required.

The usual dose:

Apply a thin layer of UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP over affected area. Do it two or three times daily.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue using UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

If you forget to use it, do not worry. Apply the cream and continue as normal.

If you have any further questions on the use of this medicine, ask doctor or pharmacist.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Apply the cream evenly over the skin. If you are accidentally use more than usual, do not worry as it not cause any harm over the affected area applied.

While you are using UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP

Things you must do

This cream is for external use. Make sure the cream is applied over the affected area.

- Things you must not do

Do not start taking any new medication before you consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP to other people even they are having same condition or symptoms as you.

-Things to be careful of

Accident ingestion of the product may happen. Symptoms of accidental oral ingestion may include gastrointestinal

symptoms, particularly diarrhea. Treatment need only be symptomatic. Please refer to the doctor or pharmacist or go to the nearest Emergency Department.

Do not smoke or go near naked flames due to risk of severe burns. Fabric (clothing, bedding, dressings etc) that has been in contact with this product burns more easily and is a serious fire hazard. Washing clothing and bedding may reduce product build-up but not totally remove it.

Side effects

Like all medicines, UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Aqueous cream may be associated with immediate cutaneous reactions when used as a leave-on emollient, such as stinging, burning, itching and redness.

If symptoms persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers -> Reporting Side Effects to medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)]

Storage and disposal of UniMoist Aqueous Cream BP

Storage

Keep container tightly closed. Store below 30°C. Protect from freezing, heat and direct light.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
