## What Ketovid Shampoo is used for

Ketovid Shampoo is used to treat and prevent fungal and yeast infections of the skin and scalp.

## How Ketovid Shampoo works

Ketovid Shampoo contains ketoconazole, an antifungal which works by killing the fungus that causes the infection.

## Before you use Ketovid Shampoo

### -When you must not use it

Do not use Ketovid Shampoo if you are allergic to ketoconazole, miconazole, other azole antifungals or any other ingredients of this medicine (listed in Product Description).

### -Before you start to use it

If you have used corticosteroid treatment for a long time, slowly stop it over 2 to 3 weeks while using this shampoo to prevent your condition flaring up.

### *Pregnancy and lactation*

Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine.

### -Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

## How to use Ketovid Shampoo

### -How much to use

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully. They

may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

Apply the Ketovid Shampoo directly to the infected skin or scalp. Leave it on for 3 to 5 minutes, then rinse it off.

### -When to use it

For pityriasis versicolor (white to brown patches on the skin):

Treatment: Once daily for 5 days

Prevention: Once daily for 3 days during a single treatment course before exposure to sunshine.

For dandruff or dry, greasy scaling of the skin:

Treatment: Twice weekly for 3 to 4 weeks.

Prevention: Once every one or two weeks.

### -How long to use it

Use Ketovid Shampoo for the duration as your doctor recommends and continue using the shampoo without interruption until symptoms have completely disappeared.

Treatment period is depending on the type of infection.

If symptoms persist after 4 weeks of using the shampoo, consult your doctor.

### -If you forget to use it

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

### -If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have used too much or accidentally ingested this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

Accidental ingestion may cause nausea and vomiting, while excessive application may lead to heightened side effects, which should resolve upon discontinuation.

## While you are using it

### -Things you must do

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Ketovid Shampoo.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medication.

### -Things you must not do

Do not stop using the medicine unless advised by your doctor.

Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Ketovid Shampoo to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

### -Things to be careful of

Avoid contact with the eyes. If contact does occur, rise with cold water.

## Side effects

Like all medicines, Ketovid Shampoo can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Ketovid Shampoo is generally well tolerated. Some reported side effects include:

- Burning, itching, or inflammation on the skin.
- Dry or oily hair and scalp (rare).
- If your hair is damaged or you have grey hair, the color might change a bit.
- Skin rashes or hair loss with the shampoo (very rare).

## Storage and Disposal of Ketovid Shampoo

- Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 30°C.

Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
