COMPOSITION

15.0 % w/v Calamine 5.0 % w/v 0.5 % v/v Liquid Phenol Preservative: 3.0% w/v Propylene Glycol

PHARMACODYNAMICS

Calamine has a mild astringent action on the skin and is used in lotions to relieve the discomfort of dermatitis. Astringent is sometimes needed to reduce the extent of weeping.

Calamine lotion cools the skin by evaporation and is useful for allaying the pain and swelling of sunburn.

PHARMACOKINETICS

Absorption: Phenol readily penetrates skin, mucous membranes and other tissues.

INDICATION

For the relief of pruritus such as dermatitis and sunburn.
