

**HOVID CALAMINE LOTION WITH MENTHOL**

VICAL11-var (MY)

**DESCRIPTION**

Pink lotion.

**COMPOSITION**

Calamine	15.0% w/v
Zinc Oxide	5.0% w/v
Liquefied Phenol	0.5% v/v
Menthol	0.4% w/v

Preservative: Propylene Glycol	3.0% w/v

**PHARMACODYNAMICS**

Calamine has a mild astringent action on the skin and is used in lotions to relieve the discomfort of dermatitis. Astringency is sometimes needed to reduce the extent of weeping.

**PHARMACOKINETICS**

Absorption: Phenol readily penetrates skin, mucous membranes, and other tissues.

**INDICATION**

To relieve discomfort due to various skin disorders such as eczema, prickly heat, non-poisonous insect bites, pruritus and sunburn.

**SYMPTOMS AND TREATMENT OF OVERDOSE**

Clinical features: Anorexia, nausea, vomiting, epigastric discomfort, diarrhea  
Treatment: Gastric lavage and aspiration, symptomatic measures

**MAIN SIDE/ADVERSE EFFECTS**

Hypersensitivity reactions may occur occasionally.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION**

Apply on the skin as required and allow to dry.
