What Calazin Cream is used for

Calazin Cream is used to relieve skin inflammations characterized by redness, itching and skin irritations.

How Calazin Cream works

Calamine and zinc oxide have mild astringent action to provide soothing and protective effect when applied to the skin.

Before you use Calazin Cream

- When you must not use it

Do not use this medicine if you are allergic to calamine or zinc oxide or any other ingredients of this medicine (listed in Product Description).

- Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and lactation

Please consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant, planning for pregnancy or breast-feeding before using any medicine.

- Taking other medicines

Consult your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Calazin Cream

- How much to use

Apply to the skin as required.

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully.

They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet.

If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Apply as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Apply Calazin Cream for the duration as your doctor or pharmacist recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Apply the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to apply the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not apply a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have used too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

The symptoms of overdosage are eating disorder, nausea, vomiting, epigastric discomfort and diarrhea.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are using Calazin Cream.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while using this medication.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using the medicine unless advised by your doctor.

Do not use any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Calazin Cream to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

For external use only.

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how Calazin Cream affects you.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Calazin Cream can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after using this medicine.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFT)]

Storage and Disposal of Calazin Cream

- Storage

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

Store below 30°C. Protect from freezing.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
