

THREE LEGS YELLOW LOTION

Acriflavine 0.1%w/v

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What Three Legs Yellow Lotion is used for

It is used as an antiseptic for treatment of skin lesions, cuts, abrasions, infected wounds and burns.

How Three Legs Yellow Lotion works

It contains acriflavine which is slow-acting antiseptic.

Before you use Three Legs Yellow Lotion

- When you must not use it

Do not use it if you are allergic to acriflavine.

Not to be taken. For external use only. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

Discontinue use if irritation occurs.

Prolonged use may delay wound healing.

- Before you start to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- Taking other medicines

Please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Three Legs Yellow Lotion

- How much to use

Clean and dry the affected area and then apply the solution 2 to 3 times a day.

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information

contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to use, apply it as soon as you remember. Continue to use it as directed by your doctor or on the package label.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If you have used too much Three Legs Yellow Lotion, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poisoning center immediately.

While you are using Three Legs Yellow Lotion

- Things you must do

Inform your doctor or pharmacist of all the medications you are taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.

Do not give Three Legs Yellow Lotion to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

Side effects

The application of acriflavine could cause photosensitivity.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after taking this medicine.

You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by visiting the website npra.gov.my [Consumers -> Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)].

Storage and Disposal of Three Legs Yellow Lotion

- Storage

Store below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
