Methyl Salicylate 50%w/v, Camphor 10%w/v, Menthol 8%w/v

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What Three Legs Roll On Liniment is used for

It used for symptomatic relief of muscular pain, joint pain, rheumatic pain and sprain.

How Three Legs Roll On Liniment works

Methyl salicylate, menthol and camphor are external analgesics which stimulate sensation of warmth and/ or cold. This produces a counter irritant response which provides temporary relief of minor aches and pains of muscles and joints associated with backache, arthritis, strains and sprains.

Before you use Three Legs Roll On Liniment

- When you must not use it

Do not use in patients with aspirin or salicylate idiosyncrasy.

Patient with known hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients in the product.

This product is contraindicated in children below 2 years of age. Caution must be exercised when older children are treated.

- Before you start to use it

Initially apply a small amount to a limited skin area and observe whether there is discomfort or itch before applying to a larger skin area.

Discontinue use if irritation develops.

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- Taking other medicines

Please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

For patients taking warfarin, excessive application on to the skin for muscle or joint pains may increase the chances of bleeding.

How to use Three Legs Roll On Liniment

- How much to use

Apply onto affected area 2 to 3 a day.

For external use only. Not to be taken. Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist carefully. They may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

Continue to use it as directed by your doctor or on the package label.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Symptoms include headache, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, skin irritation, contact dermatitis, rash, itching, redness or swelling, burning or stinging sensation, may controlled by reducing the dosage.

While you are using Three Legs Roll On Liniment

- Things you must do

Inform your doctor or pharmacist of all the medications you are taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.

- Things to be careful of

Avoid contact with the eyes and mucous membrane. Do not apply to open wounds

or damaged skin. Avoid excessive use during pregnancy and lactation. Do not apply over large areas of the body or bandage or use with heating pads.

Ask your health care provider any question you may have about how to use Three Legs Roll On Liniment.

Side effects

Headache, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, skin irritation, contact dermatitis, rash, itching, redness or swelling, burning or stinging sensation may occur.

May cause hypersensitivity/ allergic reactions in some individuals with sensitive skin.

Storage and Disposal of Three Legs Roll On Liniment

- Storage

Store below 30°C. Away from direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
