

KALNEURON FILM COATED TABLET

Thiamine mononitrate 100mg, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride 200mg and Cyanocobalamin 200mcg

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What Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet is used for

Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet is indicated for neurological and others disorders associated with disturbance of metabolic functions influenced by B complex vitamins, including diabetic polyneuropathy, alcoholic peripheral neuritis and post influenzal neuropathies

Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet is also recommended for the treatment of neuritis and neuralgia of the spinal nerves, especially facial paresis, cervical syndrome, low back pain, ischialgia.

How Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet works

Kalneuron is a combination of three essential neurotropic vitamin (B1, B6 and B12) in high dosage. Vitamin B1, B5 and B12 are of special importance for the metabolism in the peripheral and central nervous system. Their effect on the preparation of nerves has been shown in various investigations using the vitamins individually and in combination. Vitamin B1 plays an important role in major metabolic processes. Vitamin B6 has an analgesic effect. Vitamin B12 ensures blood cell formation and prevents degenerative processes of the nervous system. Both individual function and the beneficial

biochemical links between the three vitamins justify their combined use.

Before you use Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet

- When you must not use it

Do not take Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet if you have hypersensitivity to entecavir or any component of Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet.

Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet contains sugar, do not take Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet if you are intolerance to some sugars.

Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet is not suitable for the treatment of children due to the high content of active ingredients.

- Before you start to use it

Inform and discuss with your doctor or pharmacist, if:

- you are pregnant
- you are breastfeeding
- you are taking any other medicines (including any that you get without a prescription)

Your doctor will decide whether Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet is suitable for you or not.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Your doctor or pharmacist will advise whether you should take Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet together with any other medicines.

How to use Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet

- How much to use

Take 1 coated tablet 3 times daily or as prescribed by your doctor. Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet should be swallowed without chewing with a little liquid or after meals.

- When to use it

Use as per instruction on the label and as directed by your doctor.

- How long to use it

Continue taking Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Prolonged overdose of vitamin B6 i.e., for > 2 months and > 1 g/day, may lead to neurotoxic.

If overdose occurs, contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell your doctor and pharmacist if you are allergic to vitamins B1, B6 and B12.

Tell your doctor and pharmacist about any prescription and non-prescription medications you are taking.

Inform all doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

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<p>- <u>Things you must not do</u> Do not share Kalneuron Film Coated Tablets with other people, even if their symptoms seem similar to yours.</p> <p>Do not take this medicine for other treatments unless directed by your doctor or pharmacist.</p>	<p>Storage and Disposal of Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet</p> <p>- <u>Storage</u> Kalneuron Film Coated Tablet should be stored in the original package at temperatures not above 30°C. <p>- <u>Things to be careful of</u> Vitamin B1, B6 and Vitamin B12 are secreted into human breast milk. In individual cases, high doses of vitamin B1, B6 i.e., > 600 mg daily, may inhibit the production of breast milk.</p> <p>Inform your doctor if you are breastfeeding.</p>	<p>- <u>Disposal</u> Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste.
